On Thursday 9 June 2022 at 2pm (unless sold prior to auction) The auction will be held at the property and all prior viewings are strictly by appointment through Cooper Brouard.

Rare opportunity to fully renovate or redevelop a detached Victorian cottage and large sheds on a generous size plot in an iconic coastal setting.

In the lee of Vale Church and facing a sandy beach is this traditional stone-built cottage in complete disarray but with outstanding potential to create a most desirable seafront home. Leafy Cove is one of only six cottages along a historic part of the north-west coast that resounds with a sense of bygone Guernsey. Standing 50 yards from high water, the overgrown plot is 200 feet in length and has a road frontage of 110 feet. Across the road is the coastal path between L'Ancresse and Grandes Rocques, with Les Amarreurs harbour and golf links a short stroll away.

The cottage is of traditional stone-built construction under a slate roof and measures 1,000 square feet on the ground floor with further accommodation on the first floor. There are also front and rear flat-roof porches. The sheds are close-to and of mainly timber construction. The larger measures 480 square feet and the smaller shed is 190 square feet. The parallel-sided plot is 200 feet in length at its mid-point and the slightly-angled road frontage measures 110 feet. Measurements are approximate and taken from the States Cadastre records.



Viewings: Viewings are strictly by appointment through Cooper Brouard. WARNING Care must be taken when viewing the property as the cottage, sheds and grounds are hazardous in places.

Finding the property: Follow the main road along Grand Havre from L'Islet towards Vale Church. Turn left at the kiosk car park onto La Garenne, heading towards Les Amarreurs. Leafy Cove is the fourth property on the right.
